Not only will people from the community be involved, our members, and their children, will be involved as well. After the overwhelming response to the Mayor's Youth Summit, we knew we needed to do our part to try and make a difference in the lives of our local youth."

The project will begin in August and end in November with a completion ceremony.

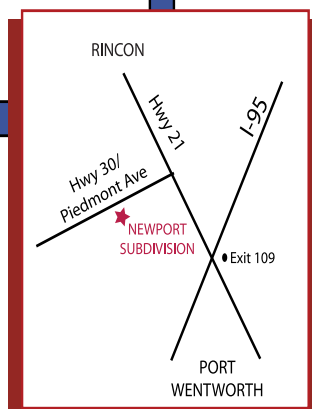
