Come and be a part of God's great gathering of His Harvest while it's yet still day. Last teachings will be June 5th at 7pm at Headquarters.

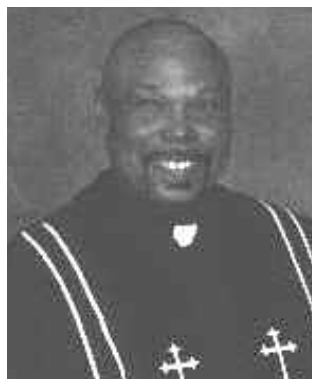
