The presentation featured the HCFS Covenant X study group's preliminary plan for "Closing the Racial Digital Divide" in Savannah-Chatham County.

Dr. Tyrone D. Taborn, CEO, Career Communications Group, wrote in Tavis Smiley's THE COVENANT WITH BLACK AMERICA, that "In recent years, there has been much discussion sur-

rounding black participation in digital technology. Studies and reports have exposed the gap between blacks and whites in computer ownership and Internet access. Both are important subjects, but narrow in their scope. More recently, the discussion has advanced to digital inclusion, as well as African American participation in areas such as business development and content creation."
